**COVID-19** Please remember:

- If <u>any</u> member of the household has <u>ANY</u> symptoms <u>ALL</u> members of the household must isolate until a negative PCR result is obtained.
- The lateral flow home tests cannot be used for Primary school children.
- Lateral flow tests are a preventative measure to identify asymptomatic cases of COVID-19 in adults.

We have had a small number families using lateral flow tests to 'rule out' COVID-19 but in this instance if your child is displaying any symptom, a PCR test must be taken.

By continuing to work together and follow all advice we can help to reduce current transmission rates even further.
